Through the Empower Us program, those experiencing homelessness can gain valuable work experience and income by collecting and delivering furniture and household items to our Welcome Home clients.

This is not a handout. It is a hand up.

Our movers earn a salary and build a work history while they work toward obtaining their own housing. They develop skills, gain confidence, and become part of a team that is serving their own community.

By addressing root causes of homelessness - instability, isolation, lack of opportunity - Empower Us fosters self-sufficiency and community integration.

Because a job is more than a paycheck. It is dignity.
